Writing for All Learners Teaching Instructions

Every learner is different. Students will likely be starting from very different places. Teachers are encouraged to adjust the teacher guides included throughout based on the needs of their learners. The goal is to set expectations to encourage growth in skills and allow students to experience success.

Section A – Reading Comprehension Check

To be completed shortly after reading the associated book. To complete this section turn to the indicated page and ask the question provided. Students need only answer verbally. If necessary have the student read the appropriate text from the book to provide the needed comprehension cues.

Section B – Handwriting Practice

Students should write the sentence indicated at least once on the lines below. Once the student has copied the letters correctly the practice should be completed. Following the writing of each line the teacher should review the students work. For any words copied correctly indicate success by drawing a line through or highlighting the correct word(s) in the model. For the next line of practice the student should only copy the unmarked words they have not completed. Set 1 includes a high level of scaffolding to support handwriting practice. These supports are gradually removed from Set 1 through Set 4.

Section C – Written Expression Practice

Students should use the picture a cue to develop three connected sentences and write them down. Students may need support in developing their story. If needed talk with the students about what they are going to write. If needed the teacher can write down the sentences for the student and the student can then replicate them. These supports should be faded as students progress.
